- b. Draw a different set of coins that could be in Lee's bank.



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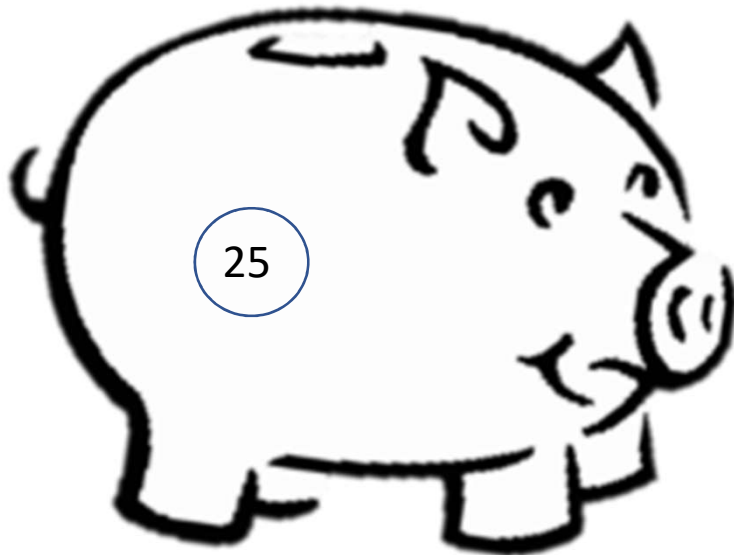
- a. The value of one dime is 10 cent(s).
